The ELEGANT Study – A clinical trial that compares the study drug elacestrant to standard endocrine therapy for estrogen receptor positive (ER+)/HER2-negative high-risk early stage breast cancer that has spread to the lymph nodes

Study Aim

The **ELEGANT trial** compares the study drug **elacestrant** to **endocrine therapy** in patients with **early-stage, node-positive breast cancer** that has a high risk of recurrence.



You may be able to take part in the ELEGANT Study if you:



Are **18 years** of age or over



Have been diagnosed with **early-stage, node-positive breast cancer** that could recur



Have been receiving **endocrine therapy** for at least 2 years following surgery

Study Design



SCREENING: 28 DAYS

You will have tests to see if you can take part.



STUDY TREATMENT: 5 YEARS

If eligible, you will take either elacestrant or standard endocrine therapy every day. You will also visit the study center for tests.



FOLLOW-UP

28 days after your final dose of study treatment and every year thereafter, the study team will check on your health.

You will have a **50% (1 in 2)** chance of receiving the **study drug elacestrant** and a **50%** chance of receiving **standard endocrine therapy**. This is done by random assignment, like flipping a coin.

Study Tests

Some of the tests you will have at the study center include:

	Measurement of your blood pressure, pulse, breathing rate, and body temperature
	You will complete questionnaires about how breast cancer is impacting your life and how you are feeling after receiving study treatment
	Collection of your blood to check for signs of cancer and your overall health
	Recording the electrical activity of your heart, called an electrocardiogram or ECG
	Scans of your body will be taken to check your condition
	Evaluation of your bone density at screening and at years 2 and 4 of the study
